The Roads to Circuit



Beginner's route

Arrive on time

Avoid Return Trip

Travel time:
Approx. 70min to 200min

Beginner's route

Kintetsu train + shuttle bus + walking

Shiroko Route

Advantages

Main route/Comfortable if avoiding peak times

Disadvantages

Longer bus wait times possible at certain times

[Limited Express] Approx. 40min
[Express] Approx. 50min

Travel time:
Approx. 100min

Kintetsu train + walking

Hiratacho Route

Advantages

Easy to coordinate times/Can enjoy the cuisine of Suzuka

Disadvantages

Longer walking distance/Transfers required

Outbound trip
Return trip

Kintetsu Nagoya Station
Ise-Wakamatsu Station

[Express] Approx. 45min

Limited Express does not stop
Transfer to Kintetsu Suzuka Line

[Local] Approx. 10min

Kintetsu Hiratacho Station

Walking:
Approx. 45min (3 km)

Suzuka Circuit Main Gate

Travel time:
Approx. 95min to 275min

Avoid Return Trip

JR (Ise Railway) + walking

Ino Route

Advantages

Close to the east course/No transfers required

Disadvantages

Return trip is very crowded./IC cards not accepted, cash only

Outbound trip
Return trip

JR Nagoya Station
Suzuka Circuit Ino Station

[Local/Rapid] Approx. 60min

Transportation IC cards not accepted

Walking:
Approx. 25min (1.5 km)

Suzuka Circuit Corner Gate 1

Walking:
Approx. 10min (0.7 km)

Wait time
MAX 180min
Peak hours:
16:30 to 18:30
